
TITLE: Firecamp Stories Remixes



Nettle is DJ /rupture & DD. For Firecamp Stories they invited an international array of musicians and sound artists to remix material from Nettle's debut album, Build A Fort, Set That On Fire (AG016).

Spurred on by the unique Nettle material—heavily textured desert music referencing the shifting street beats of deep Brooklyn, south Spain, and North Africa-the musicians poured an unusual level of passion and attention into the project, resulting in everything from hiphop-gnaoua fusion (US expat /Rupture and one of Morocco's premiere vocalists, Nass Marrakesh's Aziz Arradi) to dubbed-out techno breakbeats (Japan's Com.A and DJ Shiro the Goodman) and conceptual sound-art (Alejandra & Aeron, I/O).

Leafcutter John conjured a touching 21st-centry folksong with voice, guitar, and laptop processing; plunderphonic Donna Summer crammed Nettle soundbites into his post-disco mentalist mix. Tokyo's Joseph Nothing went cinematic (think Ozymandias trudging in the desert) while Osaka's Ove-Naxx forged a breakneck stormer from equal parts compositional elegance and upbeat brutality. Agriculture/WE's DJ Olive and Mentol Nomad from the Wordsound camp both turned in unhurried, near-ambient breakbeat pieces.
